POLICE SEEK HELP IN FINDING WITNESSES

Northumbria Police are seeking assistance in tracing a white van, possibly owned by a bouncy castle operator, following a fatal accident in Wallsend, Tyne and Wear.

The police request reads,

“We are trying to trace potential witnesses following a fatal road traffic accident on Saturday the 19th January 2007.

This accident occurred at 11pm in the Walton Gardens, Wallsend, Tyne and Wear. Firemen at the scene spoke to a man and woman in a white coloured small van, possibly W reg, with double back doors and Bouncy Castles written on these doors in red with some other blue writing beneath. These people had spoken to the driver involved in the accident and it is important that we trace them.

So far all telephone enquiries have failed to trace these witnesses. Would it be possible for you to put details of this request onto your discussion forum in an effort to trace these witnesses.
